- Multiple dimensions
- Subjective measures of poverty and relationship to life satisfaction and happiness
- In-kind benefits, consumption, wealth, or time poverty and their interrelationships
- Dynamics and intergenerational mobility
- Sustainability, capability, or opportunity

Our aim is to include country-specific and cross-national studies from both advanced and developing countries.

Papers on related topics of interest to IARIW members (both theoretical and applied) will also be considered. If you know a colleague who is working on one or more of these topics, we would be grateful if you would forward this invitation to him or her.

- Send email message of interest with title, author(s), and abstract: September 15, 2014
- Submission of paper: October 30th, 2014
- Initial Screening: December 1st, 2014
- Reviews Completed: March 1st, 2015
- Final Manuscripts Due: April 1st, 2015
- Publication: Summer 2015.
