## **IARIW-ESCoE Conference on Intangible Capital**

The IARIW and the Economic Statistics Centre of Excellence (ESCoE) have organized an in-person conference entitled "Measuring Intangible Assets and their Contribution to Growth" to take place in London, England November 11-12, 2021. A total of 23 papers will be presented. These papers represent the latest international research in the important emerging area of intangible capital, including definitional and measurement issues and effects of intangible capital on economic growth.
