

Distribution of Household Income, Consumption and Savings

Based on the guidance on the compilation and integration of household distribution results suggested in the methodology developed by the OECD Expert Group (EG DNA), Mexico presents some initial results of the distribution of income, consumption, and savings of the households in line with national accounts. The results show each transaction of the household sector accounts by quintiles, for which the information collected in the National Survey of Household Income and Expenditure (ENIGH) and administrative records were used.

Information is available for the 2008-2018 biennial series and the results cover the following topics:

- 1) Information on household income and consumption by quintiles, presenting the aspects that allow identifying the main source of income (labor income, property income, redistributive income), in coherence with the aggregates macroeconomic of the National Accounts.
- 2) As introductory elements in the analysis within the framework of the national accounts, the sociodemographic aspects of the households are presented (employment status, educational level, homeownership, and type of households).
- 3) Considering the household as a unit of observation and using equivalence scales allows obtaining comparable results that consider differences in size and composition of the household, relevant aspects in the study of social inequality gaps.

An update will be made soon with the new results obtained by the ENIGH for the year 2020, which will allow us to know the impact of the COVID pandemic on the economic well-being of households.
