This message is to update the membership on recent developments related to the Association.

### **38th IARIW General Conference**

The 38th IARIW General Conference, in collaboration with the Economic Statistics Centre of Excellence (ESCoE) and the UK Office of National Statistics is taking place at King's College London August 26-30, 2024. The preliminary program is now available at [https://iariw.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/01/IARIW-Preliminary\\_Program\\_for\\_General\\_Conference\\_Jan24.pdf](https://iariw.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/01/IARIW-Preliminary_Program_for_General_Conference_Jan24.pdf). A total of 105 papers will be presented in 35 regular sessions. There will be three poster sessions with 100 poster papers. Two two-day training sessions on the SNA and on poverty measurement will be offered on August 24 and August 25. There may also be a one-day training session on data science on August 26 (to be confirmed). The conference website being constructed by ESCoE will be

open in early Spring. This website will include the registration portal and information on accommodation options. The Association will provide the membership information on the training sessions as soon as it is available.

### **Special IARW-CIGI Conference on the Valuation of Data**

The IARIW, in partnership with the Centre for the International Governance Innovation (CIGI), held a special conference “The Valuation of Data” November 2-3, 2023, in Waterloo, Ontario, Canada. The objective of the conference was to contribute to a better and more comprehensive understanding of the value of data, Nineteen papers were presented. Diane Coyle from Cambridge University gave the keynote address. December 31, 2024 is the deadline for submission of proposals for papers.
